STRIVE Youth Services

About Us:

STRIVE Youth Services is a Transition to Work consortium made up of three youth community organisations – IMVC, Jesuit Social Services, YouthNow and subcontractor AMES Australia. Our services are offered to young people aged 15-21 years across the Western Melbourne Region - located in Footscray, Sunshine and Werribee.

Our Services:

Our aim is to work alongside you to help you develop short and long term vocational goals, create a plan to achieve them and help you on your path to achieving your goals.

- At your first meeting, we will talk about your skills, interests and your employment and education history. We will discuss the services we offer and how we can support you.
- We will then meet with you at least fortnightly at one of our sites, or as needed, in a mutual public
 place. You will be provided with your Transition Officer's mobile phone and email contact details.
 If you need help between meetings you are welcome to contact your Transition Officer or drop in
 to any of the STRIVE Youth Services sites.
- We will work alongside you to develop a Transition Plan that will include short-term and long-term
 goals that will help you consider education, training and employment pathways. We can also
 connect you with specialist support services (e.g Mental Health, Drug and Alcohol, Housing and
 Medical) to assist you to address any barriers you may be experiencing.

Pathway Options:

If you choose an employment pathway you may be referred to work readiness workshops, career tasters, industry visits, work placements or other activities. STRIVE Youth Services have a dedicated Employment Broker, who can assist to find employment or work experience.

If you decide that returning to education or training would be your preferred option, STRIVE Youth Services can assist you to find the right program and education/training provider. STRIVE Youth Services may be able to assist you to pay for the clothes you may need for an Interview or the enrolment fee to your future training or education course.

Ongoing Support:

Once engaged in education, training or employment, STRIVE Youth Services support doesn't stop until you have successfully transitioned and feel that you are no longer at risk from disengaging.

When you commence in education, training or employment, your Caseworker or the Employment Broker will make a time to visit you on site, and ensure there is sufficient support for you. You will receive ongoing support through face to face meetings where appropriate, over the phone and through social media.
