### About Us

Youth Start – Transition to Work (TTW) is made up of three community organisations: Inner Melbourne VET Cluster (IMVC), Jesuit Social Services and Taskforce. We support young people aged between 15–24 years by matching them to suitable work experience, employment and education opportunities.

TTW services are offered across the Inner Melbourne Metropolitan Region in Cheltenham, Moorabbin, Chelsea, South Melbourne, Melbourne CBD, Collingwood, Brunswick and Flemington.



## What we do

We work alongside you to help you develop your short and long-term vocational goals. Together, we'll create an action plan to get you started in achieving your career and education aspirations.

### First Meeting

First, we'll talk to you about your skills, interests, employment and education history. We'll match you to a Transition Officer who will explore the available service options and how we can support you.

### Fortnightly Meetings

Your Transition Officer will meet you every fortnight at one of our sites or a mutual public place. If you need help between meetings, you're welcome to contact your Transition Officer or drop into any of the Youth Start Youth Services sites.

### Transition Plan

We'll develop a Transition Plan that includes short-term and long-term goals, and looks at options in education, training and employment. We can connect you with specialist support services (e.g. Mental Health, Drug and Alcohol, Housing and Medical) to assist with any barriers you may be experiencing.

## Your Pathway Options

Whether is further study to gain qualifications, training or work experience to find suitable employment, we have a range of programs and activities to help you.

### Employment

We have work-readiness workshops, career tasters, industry visits, work placements or other activities to help you explore what employment pathways you are interested in. Youth Start Youth Services have a dedicated Employment Broker to help you find the right employment or work experience opportunity.

### Education and Training

If you are keen to pursue education and training options, we'll help you find the right program and education/training provider. Youth Start Youth Services may be able to help you pay for the enrolment fee into your desired training or education course.

## Ongoing Support

Once engaged in education, training or employment, Youth Start Youth Services support doesn't stop there. We will support you until you have successfully transitioned and feel comfortable where you are.

Whether you are studying, training or working, your Transition Officer will make a time to visit you onsite, and regularly check in with you for a further six months to ensure you are managing well and have everything you need.
